### Abstract Guidelines

The Scientific Committee of the **15<sup>th</sup> Scientifica Conference 2024** is pleased to invite all qualified and aspiring Physiotherapists to submit their **Scientific Abstracts** for presentation during the conference.

#### **Presentation type**

**Paper Presentations:** Presenters will have 6 minutes each: 4 minutes for the oral presentation, and 2 minutes for Q&A through a PowerPoint presentation. The mode will be offline on 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> November 2024 and online on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2024 for those who have registered online ONLY.

*Abstracts selected for paper presentations will be notified via email, along with a provided format.*

#### **Requirements for online abstract submissions**

All abstracts must be prepared according strictly to these guidelines. Incomplete or incorrect submissions will not be reviewed. We encourage early submission to ensure prompt confirmation and processing.

1. The abstract must be written in ENGLISH.
2. The submitting author must be the presenting author, as correspondence will be with the presenting author, although presenting author does not have to be the first named author listed on the abstract.
3. Only one presenting author per paper is permitted.
4. The body of the abstract is limited to **300 words** (excluding the title and information on authors) and shall be sent in the format mentioned under "**Abstract Structure**".
5. All presentations must describe original work to which all the authors listed have made a significant contribution. Any reference to personal experience should be clearly labelled as such.
6. Abstracts whose authors do not register with full payment will be withdrawn.
7. Only Presenting authors **will** receive a certificate of presentation.
8. Only primary research will be accepted
9. The abstracts should be made and sent in word format only (MS office Word).
10. Research or studies that have awaited results will not be accepted.
11. For scientific paper presentation **registration is compulsory.**
12. Kindly send a scanned copy of your highest degree certificate in case if you have completed your graduation and in case of a student send a scanned copy of college ID with the date issued.

### Technical Requirements

- **Alignment:** Justified
- **Paper size:** A4
- **Title:** Times New Roman, Font size - 14, Upper case, Centred text in bold.
- **Body:** Times New Roman, Font size — 12; Line spacing: **1.**

<b>Title</b>	<b>TITLE OF THE ABSTRACT</b>
<b>Author (s)</b>	Name with affiliation.
<b>Category</b>	Undergraduate / Postgraduate / Professionals.
<b>Purpose</b>	Aims and objectives of the study should be explained briefly.
<b>Relevance</b>	The contribution of the study to clinic evidence and practice of physiotherapy.
<b>Participant information and Methods</b>	A brief description of number of participants, their recruitment for the study, method of sampling, and their characteristics. Insights on methodology should also be included.
<b>Analysis</b>	A brief description on the type of qualitative/quantitative data analysis used to assist you in interpreting your data.
<b>Results</b>	A short summary on the main findings derived from your analysis
<b>Conclusion</b>	Mention the conclusion and future scope of your research work.
<b>Implications</b>	Clinical implications of the study and how it can add value to the physiotherapy community in general.
<b>Keywords</b>	Maximum three keywords that describe your research best

### Selection Criteria

The following selection criteria will be used to review the abstracts:

- Clearly and concisely written abstracts Titles that describe the research clearly
- Aims and object clearly defined in clinical context
- Methodology and results including the key highlights of the study
- Specific and apt mention of statistical tests, not too elaborative.
- Implications of the research clearly defined.
- Future scope of the research included.
- Translational value



### **Review process:**

Upon submission, the papers will undergo an initial screening by the editorial team to check for adherence to submission guidelines, relevance to the conference theme, and overall quality. The paper submission shall be checked for ensuring originality in written work Anti-Plagiarism tool.

**Plagiarism should be less than 10 %.**

After the initial screening, papers will be assigned to reviewers who have expertise in the relevant subject matter. Reviewers will be selected based on their experience and qualifications, ensuring they have no conflict of interest with any of the submissions.
