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## Scientifica November 2024 Student Forum Events

### General rules:

1. All team members **must have** 15<sup>th</sup> Scientifica 2024 Registration.
2. In case of Team events, one member of the team must be appointed as team leader who will communicate with Student Forum coordinator.

### Event 1: Clinical Debate

**It is a challenging debate contest on research/ current trends in physiotherapy which will test your ability to prove your point!**

### Rules and regulations:

**The Clinical Debate is an event ONLY for postgraduate students.**

1. Postgraduate physiotherapy students of all specialties can participate.
2. It is a team event. 3 students per team can take part.
3. After registration, team leader should contact the student forum coordinator and email the names, contact numbers, email IDs and registration details of the team members to [studentforum.scientifica@gmail.com](mailto:studentforum.scientifica@gmail.com)
4. Last minute entries/ change in team members will not be entertained.
5. The event will be conducted OFFLINE.
6. **Topic** will be given a day prior with the random allocation of the Affirmative/ Pro team & Negative/ Con team.

### Basic Debate Format

1. **Opening Statements:** The speakers of each team present their case. (2 minutes per team member.)
2. **Rebuttals:** Each team responds to the arguments presented by the opposing team. (5 minutes per team.)
3. **Cross-Examination:** The judge questions the teams to clarify points or highlight weaknesses in their arguments. (2 minutes per segment.)

## **Game 2- Quiz**

**Assess your knowledge, skills, or abilities through a series of questions.**

**Team:** Each team can have 4 members with a maximum of 2 members from the final year.

### **Rules and regulations:**

1. Undergraduate students can participate.
2. Each team can have 4 members with a maximum of 2 members from the final year.
3. Last minute entries or change of team members will not be entertained.
4. The event will be conducted OFFLINE.
5. Decision of the quiz master will be final in case of disagreement.
6. This game will have 3 rounds.

### **Round 1: Dare to Demonstrate**

It is a round which is similar to Dumb-charades which will not only put your Physiotherapy knowledge to test but will also test your creativity.

#### **How to Play:**

1. Each participant picks a chit with a technique mentioned on it.
2. The participant will get 40 seconds to organize their thoughts and demonstrate.

### **Round 2: Pictionary**

It is a round which will put your artistic side to test.

#### **How to Play:**

1. Each participant picks a chit with a physiotherapeutic term mentioned on it.
2. The participant will get 40 seconds to organize their thoughts and explain the term through drawing.
3. The catch is that you cannot use letters & draw the image of words but things related to it.

### **Round 3: Trivia**

It will put your physiotherapy knowledge and quick recall to test.

#### **How to Play:**

1. Each team will be asked a set of questions.
2. The team will get 1 point for the correct answer.

3. The questions will not be passed to another team.

### **Game 3 – Reel Making Competition**

#### **1. Team**

- The competition is open to individuals and teams of up to 3 members.

#### **2. Theme & Content**

- Reels must adhere to the given theme,
  1. Client success story
  2. Patient education/ Myth busting
  3. Interdisciplinary case discussion/ Bedside rounds
  4. Pain relief techniques
- Content should be original and created specifically for this competition.
- Reels must not contain inappropriate or offensive material, including but not limited to hate speech, explicit content, or discrimination.

#### **3. Submission Guidelines**

- Each reel must be between 30 seconds and 1 minute in length.
- Submissions must be in the following format: MP4.

- Creativity and originality
- Relevance to the theme
- Technical quality (e.g., video and audio clarity, editing)
